### **Highways England: A46 Hartley Bends improvement work**

I am writing to advise you that Skanska, working on behalf of Highways England, will be carrying out essential improvement works on the A46 at Hartley Bends.

The works will involve treating the carriageway with a High Friction Surfacing (HFS) material to increase the skid resistance of the existing road surface. This will take place over approximately 1km on both the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A46 through Hartley Bends, between the junction of Hall Lane and the turn off for Hartley Farm. These improvement works follow a programme of resurfacing carried out on a different section of the A46 two years ago.

Due to the type of work taking place and to ensure the safety of both the public and our workforce, it will be necessary to fully close a section of the A46 to through traffic during the works. We will be fully closing the A46 between Cold Ashton Roundabout and the A4 London Road, Bath in both directions. There will also be lane closures on the A4 approach to Bath / A46 junction.

The works will take place overnight and the full closures are currently programmed in for ten nights between the hours of 20:00 – 06:00 from **Monday 9 May – Friday 20 May 2016** (weeknights only).

During these closures, a clearly signed diversion will be in place and details of the diversion can be found on the map overleaf. Access will be maintained for residents and local businesses where applicable.

Please note that whilst we always aim to work to the programme, unforeseen circumstances may mean slight changes to the programme. If this happens, we will do our best to notify you as soon as possible.

We will of course make every effort to ensure that the impact of our works is kept to a minimum. We understand our works may cause some inconvenience and disruption to you, and we would like to apologise in advance and kindly ask for your patience whilst the works are taking place.

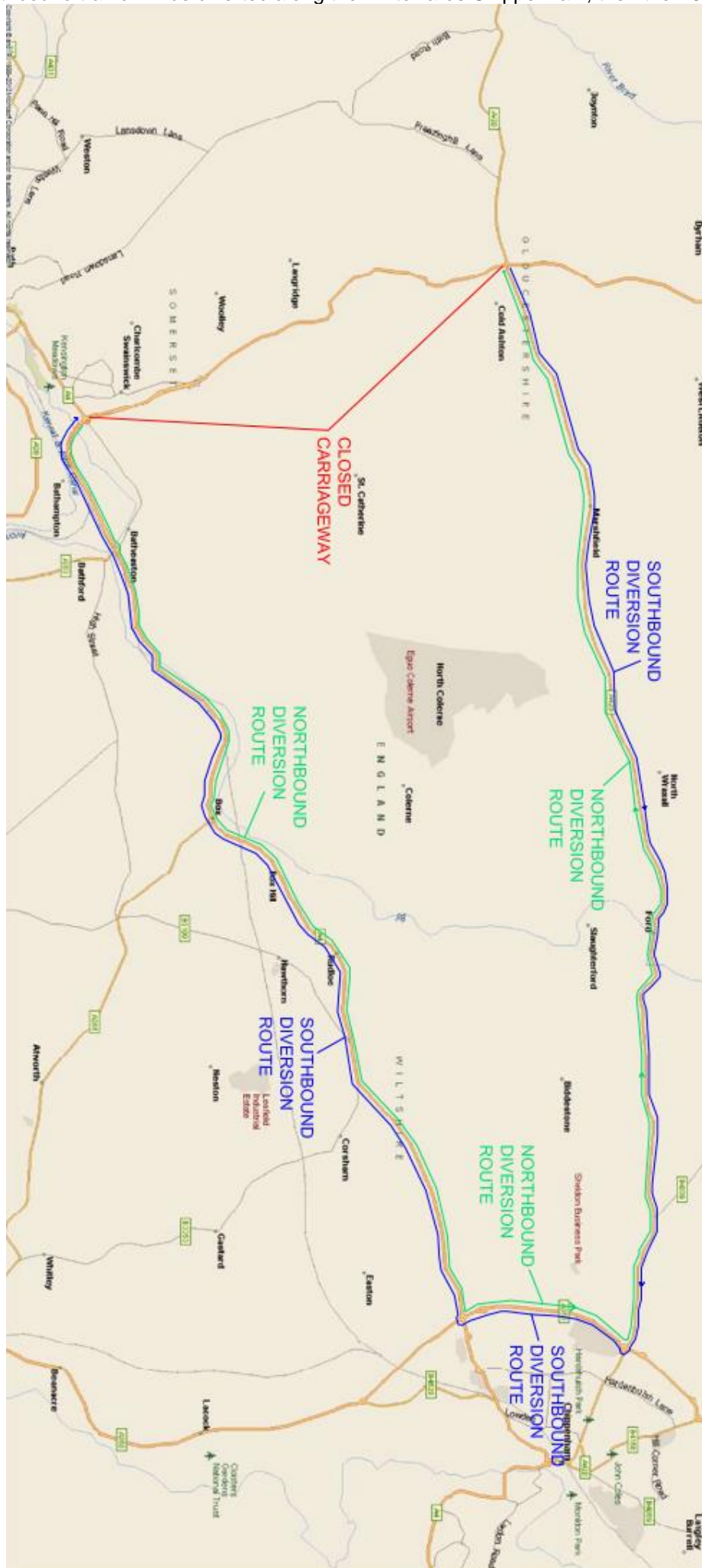
